The public is hereby notified of the availability of the final Environmental Assessment (EA) and draft Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for improvements to the existing Monument 250 Road, south of Otay Mountain Wilderness, along the U.S.-Mexico Border within the Brown Field Station's Area of Operations (AO). This EA will address the proposed improvements to the 2.14-mile road and include improvements to 19 drainage crossings.
