EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Notice is hereby given that effective on this date and pursuant to 43 CFR 8364.1 the public lands as described below are closed to all forms of entry and public use. These lands are within the Cache Creek Management Area and include the Perkins Creek Ridge Trail. The lands are located in Southern Lake County, California. The lands include portions of Mount Diablo Principle Meridian: Township 13 North, Ranges 6 and 7 West.

The closure is necessary to protect public land users from risks associated with active wildfire, and to protect wildland fire fighters from recreation activities associated with hunting of wild game. The order will remain in effect while CalFire and the BLM work to control and remove the threat of active wildland fires from the area.

The following persons are exempt from the identified restrictions:


- 1) Federal, state, or local law enforcement officers, while engaged in the execution of their official duties.
- 2) BLM personnel or their representatives while engaged in the execution of their official duties.
- 3) Any member of an organized rescue, fire-fighting force, or emergency medical services organization while in the performance of their official duties.
- 4) Any member of a federal, state, or local government agency while in the performance of an official duty.
- 5) Any person in receipt of a written authorization of exemption obtained from the authorized officers

Private landowners within the restricted area and persons with valid existing rights-of-way or leases must request in writing access permission onto the public lands from the Ukiah Field Manager at the address listed below.

This Notice and maps of the affected closed area will be clearly posted at main entry points to locations affected by this Order and will be available at the BLM Ukiah Field Office.

Failure to comply with this order is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000 and/or imprisonment not to exceed 12 months pursuant to 43 CFR, subpart 8360.0-7
