Travel Restrictions

Non-Motorized Travel including foot, horse or bicycle is allowed on all trails within BLM's King Mountain Travel Management Area.

Motorized Travel in the King Mountain Area is limited to Designated Routes Shown in RED.

Motorized Travel on all other roads and trails within the King Mountain Travel Management Area is **PROHIBITED** unless specifically authorized by the BLM. Snowmobile use is prohibited within the area except on the designated routes shown in **RED**.
