- Monitor outfitters/ guides, and events; and assist with permit administration for the Special Recreation Program;
- Inspect and clean facilities/recreation sites and check for compliance with regulations pertaining to fees, parking, campfires, sanitation, safety and camping;
- Perform Wilderness Study Area monitoring and report-writing.

If in high school, volunteer must currently be working toward a high school diploma.</p> <p><b>Experience:</b> Volunteer must have good communication skills and be able to work effectively with a wide range of people and personalities, as well as work and drive unsupervised.</p>	<p>Work varies from sedentary office phases to field work requiring ability to operate a 4x4 vehicle and/or ATV (training provided if older than 18 years old).</p> <p>Field work also involves hiking in remote areas for extended periods, carrying equipment such as GPS units, cameras, etc, in a variety of weather conditions.</p>	<p>Begin by or before April 30, 2016. If still in school, may start after school ends.</p> <p>Hours are flexible; work 10-40 hours/wk.
