Position Description:	<p>The Recreation Technician Resource Assistant will perform a variety of work primarily in both the Recreation and NLCS programs, but will gain work experience through opportunities to assist multiple disciplines. A major part of this position will be to assist in inventory efforts for lands with wilderness characteristics on the Roan Plateau (based off of new information) and on King Mountain. Another major part of this position will be to assist with the Special Recreation Permit program through monitoring and administration. Additional duties may include performing visitor use counts, checking campground fee collections and compliance, and performing Wilderness Study Area monitoring and completing associated reports. In addition, the opportunity to provide assistance to other programs will be offered and specific projects have already been identified in visitor information at the front desk, hydrology, wildlife, T&E, and ecology that the intern can assist with if they so choose.</p>		
Minimum Qualifications:	<p>Education: Intern must possess a high school diploma or higher.</p> <p>Experience: No previous experience in recreation management necessary. Intern must have good communication and people skills and be able to work with and communicate effectively with a wide range of people and personalities. Intern must have the ability to drive, work unsupervised, and use computer software including Microsoft Word and Excel. Intern should also be comfortable with guidance and direction from staff for performing a variety of tasks.</p>		
Physical Requirements:	<p>The work varies from sedentary in completing office phases of the duties assigned, to field work requiring the ability to operate a 4x4 vehicle and an ATV (training will be provided). The field work also requires hiking in remote areas over rough, uneven, or rocky terrain for extended periods of time, carrying equipment such as GPS units, cameras, packs, etc in a variety of weather conditions. Hiking long distances will be required.</p>
