



FACT SHEET: Understanding the Draft Grand Junction Field Office RMP

What is this document?

The document is the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Grand Junction Resource Management Plan Revision. It outlines four possible management alternatives and also describes what the environmental and social impacts of each alternative would be.

What is the best way to review this document?

This is a large, detailed document that may seem intimidating, but once you understand how it is laid out, you'll be able to more easily find the information you are interested in.

- The Executive Summary – Gives a good overview of many key topics
- Chapter 1 – Gives an overall description of the plan and its need.
- Chapter 2 – Describes the four alternatives in detail. Page 2-22 describes how to read the tables, and page 2-23 will tell you the specific page number to find the topic you are interested in.
- Chapter 3 – This is a description of the “Affected Environment,” which is a detailed description of the resources addressed by the RMP.
- Chapter 4 – Here is the detailed impact analysis for each alternative, arranged by issues. The purpose of this chapter is to disclose the potential impacts of each alternative to the public – and to the decision-makers.
- Chapter 5 – Consultation and coordination. This details the public outreach and participation opportunities to date, as well as the consultation and coordination efforts with tribes, stakeholders and other government agencies.
- Appendices – A lot of key support information is found in the appendices, beginning with detailed maps of various potential planning decisions by alternative. Be sure to look at the table of contents for the appendices to find more detail for your particular topic.
