



## **FACT SHEET: Grand Junction RMP, Realty**

Through decisions in this RMP, the Grand Junction Field Office will meet resource needs while providing public use authorizations such as Rights-of-Way (ROWs), renewable energy sources, permits, and leases.

Key realty alternative descriptions are described in volume 1 found on pages 2-150 to 2-162. Description of the affected environment begins on page 3-195, and possible impacts to realty are analyzed in in Volume 2 beginning on page 4-315. Descriptions of stipulations and best management practices are found in appendix B and H in Volume 3.

Map Figures 2-26 through 2-29 in Volume 2, Appendix A identify corridors, as well as ROW avoidance and exclusion areas. Solar and wind emphasis areas and solar energy zones are found on pages 2-86 to 2-89. Solar and wind energy potential areas are identified on pages 3-17 to 3-18.
