



FACT SHEET: Grand Junction PRMP, Realty

Through the proposed decisions, the Grand Junction Field Office would meet resource needs while providing public use authorizations such as Rights-of-Way (ROWs), renewable energy sources, permits and leases.

Key realty alternative descriptions are described in Volume 1 found on pages 2-354 to 2-367. A description of the affected environment begins on page 3-207, and possible impacts to realty are analyzed in in Volume 2 beginning on page 4-353. Descriptions of stipulations and best management practices are found in appendix B and H in Volume 3.

Map Figure 2-27 in Volume 4, Appendix A identifies corridors, as well as ROW avoidance and exclusion areas for the proposed alternative. Descriptions of proposed solar and wind emphasis areas are found on pages 2-359 to 2-361 of Volume 1. None of the previously proposed solar energy zones would be approved under the proposed alternative. Map Figure 2-87 in Volume 4, Appendix A identifies solar and wind emphasis areas. Solar and wind energy potential areas are identified on pages Figure 3-17 to 3-18.
