




Grand Junction Field Office Approved RMP FACT SHEET: RMP Lands with Wilderness Characteristics

The Approved RMP identifies 44,100 acres to be managed to protect existing wilderness characteristics:

- Maverick: 17,800 acres
- Unaweeep: 6,700 acres
- Bangs: 19,600 acres

The RMP does not change management of the Congressionally designated 75,580-acre Black Canyons Wilderness Area and 66,280-acre Dominguez Canyon Wilderness Area.

It does not change the four existing Wilderness Study Areas totaling 96,500 acres within the field office.


