The event will begin at 8:30 a.m. at the BLM Office located east of town, with a brief introduction to Geocaching and the operation of GPS units. Work will commence at Cedar Mountain around 10:00 a.m., which includes trail grooming, sign replacement, trash removal, and painting.

After the work day, there will be a free BBQ and other activities. All volunteers receive a free T-shirt and free "*Fee-Free Day Pass*" at participating Public Lands.
