### **BLM Seeks Input for Travel Planning**

CRAIG, Colo - The Bureau of Land Management is now seeking public input on route inventory for their Little Snake Field Office, Travel Management Area 1.

TMA 1 includes parts of Hiwatha, Vermillion Basin, Sandwash and the Little Bears Ears areas near Craig. The BLM Little Snake Field Office will accept public comments on route inventory through Nov. 15.

“Public comment is critical in developing a comprehensive inventory of all the routes currently existing on public lands managed by the Little Snake Field Office,” said Dario Archuleta, BLM outdoor recreation planner with the Little Snake Field Office.
