

# What is NEPA and Travel Management Planning?

## Transportation Management Planning (TMP)

- The proactive management of public access and natural resources in compliance with travel-related regulations, and according to the best land use management principles.
- Addresses all resource uses, including recreational, traditional, casual, agricultural, commercial, and educational; and the accompanying modes and conditions of travel on public lands.

## National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)

- Signed into law on January 1, 1970.
- Requires federal agencies to assess the environmental effects of their proposed actions prior to making decisions.
- An Environmental Assessment (EA) will be prepared under NEPA regulations.
