## *BLM Front Range Resource Advisory Council to meet*

Cañon City, Colo. – The BLM Front Range Resource Advisory Council (RAC) will hold their next meeting on Wednesday, April 22, 2009 at the BLM Royal Gorge Field Office at 3028 East Main Street in Cañon City.

The meeting will be held from 9:15 a.m. – 3:45 p.m. to discuss the 2009 fire season outlook, alternatives provided in the Garden Park and Shaws Park Travel Management Plan, an overview of the Statewide RAC meeting held in February, and hear a presentation provided by the Rags Over the Arkansas River (ROAR) on the Over The River proposed project.
