## *BLM Front Range Resource Advisory Council to meet*

**CAÑON CITY, Colo.** –The BLM Front Range Resource Advisory Council (RAC) will hold their next meeting in on Wednesday and Thursday, July 21-22, 2010 in Alamosa at the Inn of the Rio Grande, 333 Santa Fe Ave.

Wednesday's meeting will be held from 9:00 a.m. – 3:45 p.m. Topics for discussion will include: a manager's update from the Royal Gorge Field Office and the San Luis Valley Public Lands Center; Kerber Creek restoration; renewable energy; the Old Spanish Trail; Sangre de Christo Natural Heritage Area; and the Blanca Area of Critical Environmental Concern. The public will have an opportunity to provide comments to the RAC from 9:15 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.

The meeting will resume on Thursday from 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. with a field trip to the Blanca Wetlands and a tour of one of the area's solar plant facilities.
