## ***BLM Front Range Resource Advisory Council to meet***

**CAÑON CITY, Colo.** – The Bureau of Land Management Front Range Resource Advisory Council (RAC) will hold their next meeting from 9:15 AM – 4:30 PM on Wednesday, Apr. 27. The meeting will be held at the BLM Royal Gorge Field Office, 3028 E. Main Street in Cañon City.

Presentations at the meeting will include the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act, Final Supplementary Rules related to camping and occupancy of public lands, Guffey Gorge recreation site, brief overview on the Bald Hill Federal Application for a Permit to Drill, and a manager's update from the Royal Gorge Field Office and the San Luis Valley Public Lands Center. An opportunity for public comments is scheduled from 9:30 AM – 9:45 AM.
