



Subject: Notice of "Freezing" Colorado Legal Land Description (LLD) and Status
Databases

Attached is the subject notice for posting in your Information Access Centers. As mentioned in the public notice, on September 9, 1998, the State Office will place LLD and Status databases on hold pending conversion to the Automated Land and Mineral Record System (ALMRS) Release 1.

The freezing of the LLD and Status will be transparent to the users. The manual records will continue to be updated and will remain the "official agency record" for decision-making purposes.

This is the first of several notices to inform members of the public and employees about the activities related to ALMRS Release 1 deployment. As future databases are "frozen", appropriate notices will be distributed to provide employees and the public on the ALMRS deployment.
