Dear Interested Public:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Tres Rios Field Office (TRFO), has completed an environmental assessment (EA), and approved a decision record approving the acquisition of privately held lands within Montezuma County, Colorado. The project is located in all or parts of the following Townships, Ranges and Sections: T.36 N., R. 17 W., Sections 2, 10, 11, 14 and 15. The project is located within and adjacent to Trail Canyon, which encompasses private property within and directly adjacent to Canyons of the Ancients National Monument.

The acquisition is comprised of 920 acres of privately held lands. Upon completion of the acquisition, these lands will become part of the BLM Public Lands System to be managed under the guidelines set forth in the June 2010 Canyons of the Ancients National Monument Resource Management Plan (CANM RMP).
