The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is providing a 30 day public comment period on the preliminary Environmental Assessment (EA) for the "North Delta Grazing Permit Renewal." This Environmental Assessment will analyze the impacts of issuing permits for livestock grazing on public land managed by the BLM. Grazing permits will include terms and conditions that either improve or maintain public land health.

The BLM administers 10 grazing permits, authorizing livestock grazing on 9 allotments in the North Delta Land Health Unit, located in Delta County on the Western Slope of Colorado. The project would re-issue the livestock grazing permits with modifications to the authorization(s), allocation(s), and/or allotment specific terms and conditions.
