


# National Landscape Conservation System BLM Colorado Implementation Strategy

- **2011 National Landscape Conservation System Strategy and 7 new Policy Manuals**



# PROCESS

- Review crosswalked National and Colorado Strategies with you in March 2012
- Extracted the action items from the 2007 CO Strategy and relocated them in the implementation plan
- Gathered representatives from all CO field offices on a monthly conference call



- Reviewed with national program leads at the National Landscape Conservation System Workshop, Albuquerque in July 2012.
- Completed the text of the strategy in November 2012.
- Review with RACs and interested publics. Feb 28.
- Integrate comments
- Release final March 29, 2013.

- **Awareness in Field Offices of role in managing National Conservation Lands**
- **Recognition of commonalities, a sense of teamwork**
- **Recognition of expertise in the field**
- **Vision**


