

Fee adjustment proposal for the Upper Colorado River between Pumphouse and Radium

BLM is proposing to increase the day-use fee for the first time since the fee program began in this area in 1998 to off-set inflation and the rising costs of maintenance and operations. All the day-use fees collected are used on-site for maintenance and improvements.

The day-use fee at these sites for private users would increase from \$3 to \$5 per vehicle per day. The commercial day-use fee would be raised from \$1 to \$1.25 per person per day. The season pass would be raised from \$15 to \$20.

BLM is also considering making a change to the fee classification that would allow the day-use fee to be covered by the America the Beautiful Annual, Senior, Access and Volunteer Interagency passes. The current classification at these locations does not allow these passes to be used for day-use fees.
