COLORADO NORTHWEST RESOURCE ADVISORY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2008-04

Resolution requesting central contracting process for planning

Whereas: The Bureau of Land Management nationally has chosen to centralize its contracting process.

Whereas: The procurement process has not traditionally included funding for meaningful stakeholder participants.

Whereas: The accountability and timeliness for meaningful public involvement encouraged by the NWRAC has been difficult to achieve.

Therefore be it Resolved that the Colorado Northwest Resource Advisory Council recommends oversight and accountability by managers of the procurement process to include the desires of local stakeholders and the NWRAC.

Be it further Resolved that the NWRAC requests that the central contracting process ensure that adequate funding and time allocations are included to involve stakeholders and communities during the planning process.
