## NOTICE

*Please note the following corrections to our Notice of Competitive Lease Sale, Oil and Gas, dated June 20, 2016. The online auction is scheduled on **September 20, 2016**.*

The sale will begin at 9:30 am EDT. You can register for the sale starting today on [www.EnergyNet.com](http://www.EnergyNet.com). To participate in the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) bidding process, one must register at the auction website address above and obtain a bidder number.

Participants are encouraged to register early, to ensure they have ample time to complete all the required bidder registration steps before the start of the auction. **Please note that the BLM will make its best effort to complete the process within three business days. The BLM may not be able to timely approve registration forms submitted less than three business days before the start of the auction.**

If an entity is bidding for more than one party, they must register separate credentials, satisfy all registration requirements, and obtain a separate bidder number for each company or individual they wish to represent.

As part of the registration process, the BLM bidder qualifications are laid out on the sale notice and on EnergyNet site. Each bidder must access the EnergyNet website to self-certify that they meet the BLM's bidder qualifications. This information will be verified and approved by BLM staff. The BLM staff will verify the identity of the bidders via telephone call and confirm that the bidder does not owe the United States any monies that were due the day of a previous oil and gas lease auction conducted by any BLM office (the minimum monies owed the day of sale), or any monies owed to EnergyNet for a previous oil and gas lease auction. Once the BLM verifies the information, BLM will notify EnergyNet that the bidder is eligible to bid and then the bidder will be able to complete the registration process through EnergyNet.

For parcel **ES-001-09/2016**, the correct Federal mineral interest is **2/168**, equal to 1.2 percent. The project is managed by the Louisville District Corps of Engineers.
