

PUBLIC NOTICE

The U.S. Department of the Interior's Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will hold a public hearing on Thursday, July 31, 2008 in Wayne, West Virginia, to provide the public an opportunity to offer input regarding the East Lynn Lake Coal Lease Draft Land Use Analysis/Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DLUA/DEIS).

The public hearing will be held from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Wayne Town Hall, 1300 Norfolk Avenue, Wayne, West Virginia. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments on the DLUA/DEIS, proposed coal lease sale, the fair market value of the coal, and the maximum economic recovery of the Federal coal resources. The BLM will accept public comments on the DLUA/DEIS through September 24, 2008.
