INFORMATION NOTICE

Please note the following addendum and changes to our Competitive Lease Sale scheduled for December 3, 2009:

The Bureau of Land Management-Eastern States (BLM-ES) received a protest from Wild South on the 148 parcels within the Talladega and Conecuh National Forests in Alabama. Therefore, parcel numbers ES-001-12/09 ALES 55945 thru ES-148-12/09 ALES 56092 are being deferred from December's lease sale for further review and reconsideration. These parcels will be reoffered on a future sale date.

Lands in Section 24 under Parcel No. ES-207-12/09 ARES 56151 ACQ are committed to a Communization Agreement (CA).
