Information Notice

Please note the following corrections to the Bureau of Land Management-Eastern States (BLM-ES) Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale Notice dated December 13, 2011. BLM-ES' oral auction will be held on March 15, 2012.

The sale notice language on page 7 for "**Can I protest BLM's decision to offer the lands in this Notice for lease?**" is modified to read:

Yes. Under Federal Regulations 43 CFR 3120.1-3, you may protest the inclusion of a parcel listed in this sale notice. All protests must meet the following requirements:

- Protests must be filed within **30 calendar days of the posting date of the sale**. We must receive a protest no later than close of business on **January 15, 2012**. The protest must also include any statement of reasons to support the protest. We will dismiss a late-filed protest or a protest filed without a statement of reasons.
- A protest must state the interest of the protesting party in the matter.
- You may file a protest either by mail in hardcopy form or by fax. You may not file a protest by electronic mail. A protest filed by fax must be sent to (703) 440-1551. A protest sent to a fax number other than the fax number identified or a protest filed by electronic mail will be dismissed;
- If the party signing the protest is doing so on behalf of an association, partnership or corporation, the signing party must reveal the relationship between them. For example, unless an environmental group authorizes an individual member of its group to act for it, the individual cannot make a protest in the group's name.

The following BLM Oil and Gas Leasing Surface Use Stipulations applies to all USDA Forest Service parcels located in the Conecuh and Talladega National Forests in Alabama (parcel #s 1 thru 20), the Kisatchie National Forests in Louisiana (parcel #s 26 thru 72), and the Bienville, De Soto, and Homochitto National Forests in Mississippi (parcel #s 73 thru 90, 93, 94):

**BLM Oil and Gas Leasing
Surface Use Stipulations**

(1). Cultural Resources and Tribal Consultation

Stipulation: This lease may be found to contain historic properties and/or resources protected under the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), American Indian Religious Freedom Act, Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act, E.O. 13007, or other statutes and executive orders. The BLM will not approve any ground disturbing activities that may affect any such properties or resources until it completes its obligations under applicable requirements of the NHP A and other authorities. These obligations may include a requirement that you provide a cultural resources survey conducted by a professional archaeologist approved by the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). If currently unknown burial sites are discovered during development activities associated with this lease, these activities must cease immediately, applicable law on unknown burials will be followed and, if necessary, consultation with the appropriate tribe/group of federally recognized Native Americans will take place. The BLM may require modification to exploration or development proposals to protect such properties, or disapprove any activity that is likely to result in adverse effects that cannot be successfully avoided, minimized or mitigated.

(2). Endangered Species

Stipulation: The lease area may now or hereafter contain plants, animals, or their habitats determined to be threatened, endangered, or other special status species. BLM may recommend

modifications to exploration and development proposals to further its conservation and management objective to avoid BLM-approved activity that will contribute to a need to list such a species or their habitat. BLM may require modifications to or disapprove proposed activity that is likely to result in jeopardy to the continued existence of a proposed or listed threatened or endangered species or result in the destruction or adverse modification of a designated or proposed critical habitat. BLM will not approve any ground-disturbing activity that may affect any such species or critical habitat until it completes its obligations under applicable requirements of the Endangered Species Act as amended, 16 U.S.C. ' 1531 et seq., including completion of any required procedure for conference or consultation.

Exception: An exception may be granted if the operator agrees to implement measures developed in consultation with USDA Forest Service, USFWS, and coordination with state agencies.

Modification: The stipulation may be modified if it is determined that a portion of the lease area does not support threatened, endangered, or other special status species. Since the surface is under the management and jurisdiction of the USDA Forest Service, any waivers must meet USDA Forest Service policies/regulations and be approved by the USDA Forest Service.

Waiver: The stipulation may be waived if it is determined that a portion of the lease area does not support threatened, endangered, or other special status species. Since the surface is under the management and jurisdiction of the USDA Forest Service, any waivers must meet USDA Forest Service policies/regulations and be approved by the USDA Forest Service.

(3). Sensitive Plant Species

Stipulation: All suitable special status plant species habitat will be identified during environmental review of any proposed surface use activity. If field examination indicates that habitat of one or more of these species is present, BLM will require a survey by a qualified botanist for special status plants during time periods appropriate to each species. Operations will not be allowed in areas where sensitive plants would be affected.

Exception: An exception may be granted if the operator agrees to implement measures developed in consultation with USDA Forest Service, USFWS, and coordination with state agencies.

Modification: The stipulation may be modified if it is determined that a portion of the lease area does not support threatened, endangered, or other special status species. Since the surface is under the management and jurisdiction of the USDA Forest Service, any waivers must meet USDA Forest Service policies/regulations and be approved by the USDA Forest Service.

Waiver: The stipulation may be waived if it is determined that a portion of the lease area does not support threatened, endangered, or other special status species. Since the surface is under the management and jurisdiction of the USDA Forest Service, any waivers must meet USDA Forest Service policies/regulations and be approved by the USDA Forest Service.

(4). Invasive and Non-Native Species

Stipulation: Use of native or non-invasive plants in seeding mixtures under the direction/supervision of the USDA Forest Service will be encouraged to stabilize disturbed areas and during restoration activities. Construction sites will be surveyed for invasive species prior to ground disturbance. If invasive species are found, the proper control measures will be used to either eradicate the species from the area or minimize its spread to other areas under the direction of USDA Forest Service and BLM. If an invasive species is found on site after construction has begun, equipment will be washed before exiting the site to prevent the spread of this highly invasive species to other locations. Pre-construction monitoring for invasive plant species should be conducted to ensure early detection control.
