

Jimmy Smith Trail

This short (1/4 mile) trail accesses Jimmy Smith Lake in the spectacular White Cloud Peaks. This area offers wonderful rainbow trout fishing.



Location—Challis Area



Directions to trailhead: From Challis travel 18 miles southwest on US 93 and ID 75, then 15 miles south on East Fork Road (Forest Road 120). Turn onto the Jimmy Smith Lake Road and the trailhead is 2 miles up this road.

Much of the trail to the lake is under the jurisdiction of the Idaho Department of Fish and Game. Beyond the lake, trails are managed by the ID Fish & Game and the US Forest Service. Please contact the BLM or ID Fish & Game for more information about motorized access in this area.

Facilities include dispersed camping and a vault toilet.

The trail is generally open from May to October, depending on weather conditions. Width limit for this trail is 48 inches or less.



