

Snake Ridge ATV Trail

This trail begins on BLM managed lands near the mouth of the East Fork of the Salmon River and connects into a road and trail system on the USFS.



Location—Challis Area



Directions to trailhead: From Challis travel 18 miles southwest on US 93 and ID 75. Turn onto the East Fork Road. The trailhead is located 2.5 miles up the East Fork Road from the Highway 75/East Fork junction.

The 1.6 miles of trail on the BLM serves primarily as an access to USFS lands, but provides nice views of the East Fork Valley in its own right.

There are no facilities at the trailhead.


The trail is generally open from May to October, depending on weather conditions

Width limit for this trail is 48 inches or less.


