

Arco Pass / Wood Canyon Trail Loop

This loop road is an easy ride for most ATVs and UTVs. On the trail you can enjoy the scenery, geological formations, canyons, creeks and views of incredible wildflowers during the early spring months.



Location—Arco Area



This loop also has a large variety of wildlife viewing such as deer, antelope, coyotes, badgers and birds. It is co-managed by the BLM and US Forest Service.

The trail is generally open from May to October, depending on trail conditions due to weather. There are no vehicle width requirements on this trail.

There are no facilities along the trail, but the trail does start and end in or near the town of Arco, which has full services.
