

# Big Southern Butte Trail

Big Southern Butte is one of the largest volcanic domes in the world, yet is one of the youngest (300,000 years old). The area supports vegetation such as lodge pole pine, aspen, Douglas fir and Manzanita (not common in this area).



## Location—Arco Area



Directions: From Arco, take the Country Road/300 North heading south (this is signed at the 'Arco OHV Route'). Turn east onto Arco-Minidoka Road/2930 North. Turn onto 2900 West heading south and turn west onto 2150 North, turn north onto 300 West which turns into 2225 North. Turn onto the Arco-Minidoka Road heading south for several miles. Turn east onto Quaking Asp-Frenchman Road toward Big Southern Butte. At Frenchman's Cabin, turn and head up the butte.

Hikers and bikers who venture to the top of this 7,550 foot high summit are rewarded with spectacular panoramic views stretching for miles.


The road to the summit is open generally from May to December, depending on snow levels and road conditions. This is a road but best traveled by ATV or UTV.

No facilities are available in this area except for the town of Arco. This route is called the Arco OHV Route.
