



Fiddle Creek III
This rapid cannot be seen from the highway. Lower flows expose rocks and holes from river left to center.

Trap Creek III-IV
Higher flows create a large wave train, but as the water level drops, holes form and rocks are exposed, which require some maneuvering.

Chair Creek III
Between 28,000 and 35,000 cfs a large wave train is great fun. Below 27,000 cfs the entry wave becomes a hole.

Cherry Creek II
Waves form here at lower flows.
