

Jim McClure - Jerry Peak Wilderness


This area was designated as Wilderness on Friday, August 7, 2015, following unanimous passage into law by Congress. Different than any other form of public land, Wilderness is established as an antidote to expanding settlement and growing mechanization, a place where ecosystems remain undeveloped and intact, natural processes unfold without intervention. Humans may visit but not stay. Help protect these values for future generations.

Take time to read this map and know if your planned trails are in or out of the wilderness.

This area is closed to motorized equipment, and motorized and mechanized transport (bicycles, motor vehicles, wheeled carts, chainsaws, etc).

Existing regulations regarding stay limits, weed free hay and seasonal use of open routes are still in effect.
