
Idaho and Southwestern Montana Energy



Energy and utility corridors as well as mineral leases and withdrawals are displayed for the Idaho/southwestern Montana sub-region, including BLM and Forest Service lands. Many of the nation's mineral resources and energy corridors coincide

with important sage-grouse habitats across the western US, which could potentially affect sage-grouse if habitats are lost, fragmented, or degraded.
