

The BLM has received an application to change the season of grazing use and livestock numbers within the Bullwhacker #06181 Grazing Allotment. The Bullwhacker Grazing Allotment consists of 40,243 acres of public land located in townships 24, 25, and 26 north, and Ranges 19, 20, and 21 east, Montana Principle Meridian. The allotment is located in southern Blaine County near the northeastern edge of the Upper Missouri River Breaks National Monument (Monument), north of the Missouri River and west of Cow Creek.
