PROPOSED ACTION: The proposed action is to issue a new grazing permit to the current base property owner to allow livestock grazing to continue on the Greasewood Allotment No. 00757 with the addition of cattle. A permit would be issued for a ten year term of March 1, 2013 through February 28, 2023. The permit will read as follows:

Terms and Conditions:


Grazing is authorized during the listed season for the recognized capacity of the public land. Livestock will not be on the public land continuously for the entire season.

Grazing use is authorized with the normal livestock operation. Grazing fees must be paid prior to turnout. Livestock numbers and season of use cannot exceed public land AUMS.

One cow can be grazed in lieu of the one horse. No livestock can be on the allotment for more than 3 months within the year.
