Hello, Kimberly.

I am writing to nominate some lands for federal lease sale for Crescent Point Energy USA Corporation. It is possible that some of these lands have already been nominated and are in process. If this is the case please disregard this request and please advise as to where things are currently with the attempt to get these lands onto a BLM lease sale.

I have included an email chain below where some discussion took place between yourself and a landman at Crescent Point regarding some of these parcels in case it could be helpful to you. All of these lands are in Williams County, ND.

The first parcel is one that is not developed and is unlikely to have been nominated already:

**Township 159 North, Range 100 West**  
**Section 30: NENE**

\*This parcel is the one that is part of the Lake Zahl National Wildlife Refuge and appears to be both federal surface and minerals.

The second parcel or parcels are currently under a spacing unit where Crescent Point Energy has drilled a well. A copy of a letter discussing the approval of the communitization agreement and well is attached. I believe that Crescent Point may have made attempts to nominate these lands in the past, however I am not 100% certain. This could still be in process considering the Fish and Wildlife Surface management.

**Township 158 North, Range 101 West**  
**Section 1: NW (50% Federal Minerals)**  
**Section 1: N2NE****(Fish and Wildlife Surface Management)**
