There are two plugged and abandoned wells in this area.

Portions of 11 grazing allotments overlap the unit and there are many small reservoirs and over 30 miles of interior fences. Many miles of vehicle routes run throughout the unit. Many of these routes are associated with the fences and reservoirs. Some routes are maintained and provide access to private lands.

During inventory team review it was determined that this inventory unit does not meet the naturalness criteria for wilderness characteristics based on the above conditions.
