The MT State Chapter of the NWTF would like to announce their summer “Request for Super Fund Proposals” for proposals to be considered at their Summer Board of Director’s meeting July 15th-17th, 2011 in Havre, MT. This request for proposals applies to all **“habitat-related”** projects, which would include land acquisitions, conservation easements, or access projects. Five-star requests (JAKES, WITO, Wheelin’ events, Scholarships etc.) will not be subjected to the deadline below, but please turn these requests in as soon as you know an event will be held. Included in this request is an electronic proposal form to be filled out and submitted either via postal mail or email (preferred) to the MTNWTF Super Fund Coordinator. Please ensure that all the information on the proposal form is filled in completely, as proposals will be ranked according to the information provided on the form. Proposals received on forms other than the MTNWTF proposal form provided WILL NOT be considered for funding. Any funding received for habitat projects, land acquisitions, or similar projects will be awarded as a cash award (to be determined by the board) and a large \$100 aluminum sign that is to be placed at the project site highlighting project partners.
