The Bureau of Land Management's Butte Field Office has posted a proposed Travel Management Plan and Environmental Assessment for the Missouri River Foothills area online and is looking for public input as it develops the plan. The BLM would like to hear from the public on issues, concerns, or alternatives that should be evaluated as we work on establishing a travel route network in this area. We've completed a comprehensive travel route inventory and are now seeking additional input as we look to finalize the travel plan.

The Travel Management Plan and Environmental Assessment looks at four different route alternatives in the Missouri River Foothills, located at the base of the Big Belt Mountains in Broadwater and Lewis and Clark Counties.
