Below are the Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Proposed Decision regarding management of BLM-administered lands (83,102 acres including 36 grazing allotments within the Centennial Watershed (CW) in Beaverhead County, Montana. Three alternatives were presented and fully analyzed in the Centennial Watershed Environmental Assessment (EA) DOI-BLM-MT-B050-2015-011-EA. The EA was sent to interested parties and posted to the Dillon Field Office website in July 2015. Several comment letters/e-mails/phone calls were received and carefully reviewed and considered by the assigned interdisciplinary team (IDT) and the Authorized Officer in preparing this proposed decision.
