

Burnt Lodge WSA

Burnt Lodge Wilderness Study Area (WSA) is located along the northern boundary of Charles M. Russell (CMR) National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) in southeast Phillips County and southwest Valley County. Part of the Missouri River Breaks, this 13,730-acre WSA provides outstanding opportunities for solitude and primitive and unconfined recreation. Big game and upland bird hunting are popular activities here as are wildlife and scenic viewing.

WSAs are remote and undeveloped lands that offer primitive and unconfined recreation opportunities. Travel by mechanized or motorized means is only allowed on numbered routes. Please leave no trace of your visit so others may enjoy nature as it was intended for us.

WSAs are managed according to BLM Manual 6330 which is available at <http://www.blm.gov>.

Activities: Hiking, backpacking, primitive camping, hunting, wildlife viewing, photography, horseback riding.

Facilities/Services: None

Location/Access: Burnt Lodge is difficult to access; travel during unstable weather is not recommended. From Glasgow, Mont., travel south on Hwy 24 for 10 miles to Willow Creek Road. Travel 45 miles to Timber Creek Road and proceed for 4.3 miles, turn left for approximately 0.2 miles then right one mile to the stream crossing (CAUTION: The streambed may be impassible when wet). After crossing the streambed, follow the road to the right to the WSA boundary and Plum Creek Road. The road is steep and narrow so proceed with caution. A high-clearance vehicle is necessary.

Motorized access to the western portion of the WSA is only available through private lands or by foot or horseback from the CMR National Wildlife Refuge. Please obtain landowner permission before accessing the WSA via private routes.

Motorized and mechanized travel is prohibited off of numbered routes within the WSA.

Fees: None

Season/Hours: Open to the public year-round.


Maps: The site is on the BLM Fort Peck Lake West 1:100,000 topographic map.


