Lewistown, MT----The Bureau of Land Management will continue collaboration efforts with the public concerning implementation of forestry and fuels projects on public lands in the Judith and Moccasin Mountains by hosting a second meeting Thursday, March 1<sup>st</sup> from 6:30 – 8:00 p.m. at the Central Montana Community Center.

During this meeting, participants will describe their view of a healthy forest, prioritize projects (approved in the Judith-Moccasin Landscape Analysis), and identify potential treatment effects and related concerns. In preparation for the meeting, those who anticipate attending are requested to consider how they envision (and how they would describe) a healthy forest.

Anyone interested is encouraged to attend. Working together may provide better opportunities to implement projects, accomplish shared objectives, and coordinate treatments across ownerships.
