## Projects Completed in 2013

The Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act (FLREA) funds projects at Garnet Ghost Town to improve facilities that improve visitor experiences and protect resources for future generations. In 2013, over \$10,000 of entrance fees were spent on various improvements and projects at Garnet. The projects completed in 2013 include the following:

- ✓ Materials and labor for installation of new Vault Toilet
- ✓ New woodsheds at Rental Cabins/Volunteer Cabins
- ✓ Garnet walking trail maintenance
- ✓ Maintenance on benches at Garnet
- ✓ Maintenance on the Sierra Mine Trail
- ✓ Upgrades to the Rental/Volunteer Cabins (new woodstoves, mattress, propane stove and propane refrigerator)
- ✓ Supplies for historic building maintenance and stabilization
- ✓ Materials and maintenance on walking bridge in Garnet
