EnLink's Lobo Gathering System Project EA

June 15, 2016

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Carlsbad Field Office has posted the Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Lobo Gathering System Project and is inviting the public to comment. The BLM is the lead federal agency for the undertaking, which is proposed to cross federal, state, and private lands.

The applicant, EnLink North Texas Midstream, LP (EnLink), is proposing to construct 93 miles of natural gas gathering pipelines and associated above-ground appurtenant facilities in Lea and Eddy Counties, New Mexico and Loving County, Texas. The gathering system would include segments of 6-inch outside diameter (OD) to 20-inch OD pipelines. EnLink is requesting a 30-foot wide permanent right-of-way and a 20-foot temporary construction right-of-way, as well as locations for above-ground facilities and temporary work spaces.




