

Announcement:



The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Carlsbad Field Office (CFO) is evaluating an application for right-of-way (ROW) and invites the public to submit comments from July 1-30, 2014. The applicant, DCP Midstream, LP (DCP) is proposing to install a 66-mile, 12-inch diameter, pipeline to transport produced natural gas liquids from the Zia II gas plant in Lea County, NM to a delivery point in Andrews County Texas. The proposed pipeline and associated facilities would occur on BLM, State of New Mexico and private surface. The BLM has a responsibility under the Federal Land Policy and Management Act (FLPMA) to respond to an application for ROW for use of federal land.


