

PUBLIC NOTICE
Preparation of an Environmental Assessment
Delaware Basin 4-C North Seismic Exploration

Dawson Geophysical Company (Dawson) has filed a Notice of Intent (NOI) to conduct a 3-D vibroseis geophysical survey for the purpose of gathering subsurface geologic data for oil and gas exploration and engineering, proprietary to TRNCO Petroleum Corporation (TRNCO). Geophysical exploration is a methodology that is used to define, through geologic subsurface mapping, oil and gas reservoirs. It is possible that the data for this project may be collected in phases and/or tiers.

An Environmental Assessment will be required under the National Environmental Policy Act and Council for Environmental Quality regulations in order to assess the potential effects of the proposed geophysical exploration operation upon environmental resources in the project area. The project area is located on federal, state, and private lands approximately 0.4 miles west of Jal, New Mexico described as follows:

The BLM Carlsbad Field Office must receive comments concerning the proposed geophysical exploration project in writing by the close of business on April 07, 2014.
