Re: West Rosa Unit 3D Geophysical Exploration (Seismic) Errata Sheet

Dear Reader:

Earlier this month, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) completed and approved the West Rosa Unit 3D Exploration Environmental Assessment. There were stipulations attached to the decision as conditions of approval and the project sponsor is required to follow these stipulations throughout the project.

It has since been realized that there is (1.) a sentence used in the stipulations that is not clear and may cause confusion, therefore must be changed and (2.) additional information needed to be added to the cumulative effects to the EA.

1. The first correction refers to *“monitoring is required for shot holes drilling located adjacent to the 36 cultural resource sites listed on page one of this review”*, which can be interpreted in many different ways. Attached is the Errata Sheet to correct this error and better define the particular stipulations.
2. The second correction is to add information identified from New Mexico State Parks Cultural Resource Specialists that there is *a strong possibility for adverse cumulative effects to cultural resources from the proposed exploration of the Mancos and Dakota formations*. Attached is the Errata Sheet to address this concern.
3. The third correction refers to *“Mulch should be grass or straw spread...”* which needs clarification. Attached is the Errata Sheet to correct this error and better clarify the particular stipulations.
