




Oil and Gas Leasing Allocations

Closed areas do not allow fluid mineral development. Areas identified as no surface occupancy (NSO) are open to fluid mineral leasing, but surface occupancy or surface-disturbing activities associated with fluid mineral leasing cannot be conducted on the surface of the land. Controlled surface use

(CSU) areas are open to fluid mineral leasing but the stipulation allows the BLM to require special operational constraints. The remaining BLM-administered lands in the planning area are open subject to standard lease terms and conditions.
