# Calling all lovers... of your Public Lands.

Come explore Las Cruces' newest mountain biking and hiking trail on Saturday, November 5th!

The beautiful Sierra Vista trail has a new northern extension.

Thanks to the hard work of Boy Scout Troop 68, the Backcountry Horsemen, local geocachers, and other volunteers, the BLM has been able to add 2.5 miles of trail from Soledad Canyon Road to Dripping Springs Road. This is a non-motorized moderately difficult trail designed for mountain bikers, hikers, and equestrians.

We would like to invite you to the new Sierra Vista trailhead off Dripping Springs Road for coffee and pastries and a quick trailhead cleanup starting at 9 am. Afterwards you can enjoy hiking or biking the new trail at your leisure down to the Sierra Vista trailhead on Soledad Canyon Road. A return shuttle for hikers and bikers will be provided.

Please bring work gloves for the trash cleanup in the parking lot. Wear appropriate footwear and bring enough water and snacks for the approximately 2 hour hike.

Directions: From I-25, travel east on University Avenue. Continue past A-Mountain (Tortugas Mountain) and the Talavera neighborhood until the paved surface ends. Travel another 1.8 miles on the dirt road (which is now Dripping Springs Road) and take the only right turn. Follow this several hundred yards into the trailhead parking lot.
