Dear Interested Party,

In September 2006, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and City of Truth or Consequences, NM (T or C) entered into an agreement to work toward a proposal from the City that expressed their interest in obtaining ownership of 30.12 acres of BLM-administered land currently leased by as a landfill (see enclosed vicinity map). The landfill is currently not operating. The proposed area is maintained under jurisdiction of the New Mexico Environmental Department, Ground Water Quality Bureau (NMED).

The BLM would convey the subject landfill site under the authority of Recreation and Public Purpose Act (R&PP), which is a law administered by the BLM. The R&PP authorizes the sale or lease of public land for recreational or public purposes to State and local governments and to qualified nonprofit organizations.

To comply with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the BLM has analyzed the environmental effects of issuance of a pentent for the purpose of conveying a closed landfill to the City in an Environmental Assessment (EA). The EA (DOI-BLM-NM-L000-2013-0024-EA) will be posted on BLM's website for a 30 day review and public comment by mid-September 2014:


