

Established in 2001 by Presidential Proclamation, *Kasha-Katuwe Tent Rocks National Monument* is a remarkable outdoor laboratory, offering an opportunity to observe, study, and experience the geologic processes that shape natural landscapes.



Located within El Malpais National Conservation Area, the *Canyons Wilderness Study Area* was established in January of 1991, and is made up of sagebrush flats and piñon-covered sandstone hills.




